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### **Background of the organization:-**

Rural Organisation for Social Advancement called "*ROSA*" *Sansthan*. It is a civil society organisation of Uttar Pradesh, India, which is working in eastern Uttar Pradesh. The main target of the organisation is Dalit (most are the people of the every caste and religion who are most neglected in the society), backward and minor communities who is divided in different classes and castes. They are struggling on their level for livelihood but due to current socio and political circumstances, their whole development is not progressive as per basic need. Main objective of the organisation is promoting to national integration for a society full of justice & equity through rural organisation and such work that community could be help by them.



Its came into existence in 2003, this organization got registered under the Society Registration Act 21 of 1860, having the registration No 401 dated 21.7.2003 & Registered under Income Tax Act - 12A, No. 118/2007-08/2981, dated 30-11-2007, PAN No. - AAAAR5396P.

### **Nature of the organization:-**

Rural organization for social advancement is a Voluntary/ non political/ non profitable/ social organisation

### **Vision of the organization:-**

To promote communal and social harmony by demolishing the social injustice and inequality for maintaining the national integration for a society full of justice and equity by generating rural action.

### **Mission of the organization:-**

The social disharmony and discontent rises in the deprivation and poverty. Hence we see our primary mission as the empowerment of the people, specially the deprived and under privileged. Among them priority is given to women, children and socio-economically-weaker sections of society. Working for the holistic and sustainable development of these people, we believe that only the establishment of social justice is the right environment for creating social harmony and nation building.

### **Objectives of the organization:-**

2. To constructive efforts for the betterment of community health and family welfare through education & training.
3. To Implement rural technology & non conventional energy, proper utilization of their in the field of agriculture, animal husbandry, science & environment.

10. To interchange and help, for required resources with local people, government, non government, national & international organizations for achieving the objectives of the organisation having the similar objectives.

### **Geographical area of Intervention:-**

- ❖ 20 villages of block development Tarwa, district **Azamgarh**, Uttar pradesh, India.
- ❖ 5 gram panchayat of development block Ranipur, district **Mau**, Uttar pradesh, India.

### **Target group of the organization:-**

Women, children, Poor, deprived, small & marginal farmer, schedule caste, most backward & minorities' community of the society

### **About Intervention area:-**

#### **Social Condition:-**

General cast, backward caste, Schedule caste and minor community live in the intervention area of Tarwa development block. There is majority of the community of backward class but they are divided each other by caste discrimination. In the village side residence situated of the community on the based of caste system. The internal caste discrimination of the major problem among scheduled communities in the area. Gender



discrimination exist in the society so that women do not equally participate like men in the society. Generally it found that low caste do not own to curtain system but women of general caste own the curtain systems. Women and men celebrate

to their festival under religious customs. There is a religious place Hathyaram is situated with this area but it is situated in Ghazipur district.

### **Economical condition:-**

The main sources of livelihood in this area is farming and farming based employment and animal rearing mostly agriculture land is in the ownership of high class community of the society on which low class people work as agriculture labor and in the off seasons they migrate also to other state and cities for their livelihood. When harvesting seasons starts then people get employment and a large scale in agriculture work but in rest days farmer and labor work of animal rearing. There are two branches of local rural bank which gives facilities to people of saving and credit and private companies also credit facilities.

### **Cultural Condition:-**

Diversity is seen in the society by cultural view. The way of livelihood in the many Dalit community is about to same but custom are affected by caste system.

### **Educational status:-**

There is a primary school in every village panchayat of this area but due to lack of school teachers and no availabilities of teaching and learning materials, children are not getting qualitative education. Parents and teachers are not interested with education and no government facilities are availed in there school due to corruption by education system. Generally there is no formation of parents association it is then only in written on paper and it is cooked mixture (Khichari) at noon time under mid day meal scheme. Operation of Aganbadi is not regular and nutrition food is also under corruption. The community people are not active and aware to this. There are a many of college in the operational area and from different state students lake admission here in these colleges. The agents of these colleges are spread and work of registration of students on commission based. Class is not held in these colleges even a thousand degrees are distributed per year.



### **Status of Gram Panchayat:-**

The working area is spread in eight gram panchayat in which representative from every classes are present accordingly reservation. There are some women Pradhan also but men delegates fully their work. Representatives are called Pradhan by community. Generally it is found that meeting of gram committees are less in the paper and actually meeting is very less. Panchayat member have no knowledge about membership of panchayat committee. Open meeting of gram panchayat are not held with corm and present time gram Pradhan is controlling of all panchayat development work done by him.

## **A. Maternal & child health**

### **Background of the community health in the area**

Our works in the direction of better health for schedule & minority communities with the help of government & local stakeholders through awareness program on the problems related to the health & tries to join the last person of society to the facility provided by the government during the reporting period organisation regularly working in dalit localities of 20 village for the community health promotion.

### **Objectives**

1. To aware on primary health of children & women
2. To promote health & hygiene practices in the community
3. To promote on registration of birth & death
4. To promote on routine immunization
5. To reduce IMR, CMR & MMR.

### **Activities implemented during the year**

The following activities were implemented in the working area-

1. Organized health camps for women & children on seasonal diseases in the target villages.
2. Organized health awareness camps on six killer diseases in the target villages
3. Organized inter face camp with ANM's , ASHA & Aganbadi worker on the issue of community health specially women and children
4. Conducted training of health volunteer on community health promotion
5. Conducted training on health & hygiene with selected volunteers
6. Organized world aids day in the working area
7. Identified and registered of pregnant women & new born children

### **Out put**

- ✚ Service provided to 65% pregnant women of immunization, nutrition & proper checkups
- ✚ 54% institutional delivery promoted in the working area
- ✚ 71% immunization of 0-2 years children promoted in the working area
- ✚ Increased awareness generation in rural women on the community health in the working area
- ✚ 704 patients checkup in the health camp

## **B. Integrated child development**

### **Background of the area**

Organisation making continuous efforts to join the children of 3-14 years age group of dalit & minority community in 20 villages of its working is with the main stream of education by joining them with primary school for qualitative education. In the area school leaving children are more resulting only 30-45% attendance in school in the peak hours of agriculture activities, attendance were down



### **Objectives**

1. To promote the educational status of 3-14 years children
2. To promote the quality education on the primary schools
3. To increase the school enrollment of drop out children
4. To increase the participation of village education committee in the educational development
5. To promote functional parents teachers association
6. To increase attendance of children in primary school
7. Link working children & child labor in education program

### **Activities implemented during the year**

1. Bal sansad formation in 10 villages
2. Organized school going campaign in the 20 villages
3. Conducted training on child right
4. Conducted training of micro level planning
5. Organized bal divas celebration
6. Celebrated of national festivals
7. Support of books for poor children
8. Provided IEC materials to in the 20 villages on development
9. Meeting with children club/bal sansad
10. organized exposure of children
11. Identification of non school going, working & child labour

### **Out put**

- ✚ Drop out rate of children reduced
- ✚ Enrollment of children in primary school increased
- ✚ 10 active children group/bal sansad
- ✚ Awareness increased on right to education in parents



## **C. Community based livelihood promotion**

### **Background of the area**

Working area of organisation is rural where resource of employment is agriculture or agriculture based resources. Being insufficient agriculture land, the members of dalit & minorities community works in others agriculture land for their livelihood. Few member of the family go to big cities for employment in private sector jobs. Being short of opportunities for employment in the area remains big problems for them.

### **Objectives**

1. To reduce the child labour & working children in the area
2. To build skill of community based micro entrepreneurs in the dalit communities
3. To mobilize and make available micro credit facilities

### **Activities implemented during the year**

1. Formation of self help group in the 20 villages
2. Conducted training of SHG leaders
3. Conducted training of SHG management
4. Conducted training on MLP
5. Organized may day celebration
6. Mobilized of social securities scheme of government
7. Orientation of camps on NAREGA
8. Promotion of micro saving & credit of SHGs



### **Out put**

- ✚ 18 SHG formed in the target area specially women
- ✚ 34 SHG leaders trained on leadership of SHG
- ✚ 18 SHG leaders trained on management of SHG, meeting, book keeping & income generation program
- ✚ Conducted micro level planning in the 10 villages on community based livelihood promotion
- ✚ Awareness generation increased on agriculture labors on right to labor
- ✚ 17 widow pension, 36 house, 26 old age pension, 1 disable pension 156 job card access to the needy person by mobilizing on the same

There are so many levels for the protection of their right but tradition thinking of the society is the main obstacle in between women & empowerment.

panchayat is still a big question mark. Corruption in the implementation of projects, differentiation I implementation are the main factors due tie which last person of the society is unable to receive the benefits of the project. Due to this dream of Mahatma Gandhi's gram swaraj is still a dream.
